If you have concerns about a child, whether that be regarding physical, sexual or emotional abuse or neglect, please speak to the Safeguarding Officer of the Church (Sarah Nuthall) to discuss your concerns - or call the Multi Agency Safeguarding Hub on <u>0845 155 1071</u>.

If you are worried about a person over 18 who may be at risk of exploitation or abuse, or who is vulnerable and needs some help due to physical or learning disability, incapacity or ill-health, please discuss your concerns with Sarah or call Care Direct Plus on <u>0845 155 1007</u>.

It is better for several people to mention something and raise concerns, than for no-one to speak out and a child or adult not receive the support they need.
