

November started with the incredibly sad and shocking news of the death of Revd Robert Gordon, a beloved colleague and friend. In our family, within a week of Robert's death, my husband's sister was diagnosed with terminal cancer, and he just made it to Cape Town to see her for two days before she too passed away. It has been a tough few weeks. Today was Robert's funeral and it was the most uplifting, emotional, God-filled funeral I have been to. We continue to pray for his wife, Steph and their family.

As we prepare for Christmas, which so many people find magical and joyful, full of the wonder of the baby Jesus, I am even more aware this year, that for some, Christmas is a sad, lonely and painful time. Christmas is often when families come together to enjoy good food, good company and celebrate the birth of Jesus – and children look forward to Father Christmas bringing them presents. It is also a time, when those who have lost loved ones, find Christmas very difficult and are unable to feel the joy and fun that others experience.

As we remember and celebrate once again, the wonderful good news of Jesus coming to earth as a helpless baby, let us remember those for whom this time of year is sad. May we remember too, that Jesus' coming as a tiny baby, growing into a man who died for us and rose again, means that we have hope. We live in a world that looks largely to have lost hope. As Christians, however, we have the hope that Jesus brings – hope of a life renewed, not only here on earth, but after we leave this world, Jesus has made a way for us to be with him forever. A place where there will be no more crying, death, pain or illness. It is a place that is filled with God's awesome presence and his great love. That is the good news that Jesus brings. He came that we may be saved and live with him forever.

May the love and the hope of the Christ Child enfold you this Christmas and may you know his joy and grace.



**GROW COURSES** offer introductory learning opportunities for a wide range of roles over Zoom.

Primarily for lay people, these courses can be accessed by anyone and may be used as part of their discernment process or as learning for a current or future role.

This project aims to help our church members to grow in prayer, make new disciples and serve the people of Devon with joy through practical and specific learning.

Courses are certificated and can be undertaken without prior learning. Some participants join before or after undertaking Foundations in Christian Ministry, but these courses stand alone. Public recognition of this learning is really valuable, so we'd encourage all churches to acknowledge those who complete Grow courses. These courses can also be arranged as in-person training, if we have enough people to run a course in the Deanery.

Current courses include Digital Ministry, Prayer, Sharing our Faith, Children, Youth & Schools, Leading from the Front, Carbon Literacy, Creation Care, Pastoral Care, Social Action, Administration, Preaching, Small Group Leadership and more. These are always being added to and suggestions of new subjects are welcome.
