Easter services

Maundy Thursday at St Swithun's at 7pm - Jesus washed his disciples' feet as an act of service before the Last Supper, his final meal with them. To remember this lead into Easter, there will be foot washing, stripping the altar and a service of communion.

Good Friday - Walk of Witness in Crediton at 10am - Starting at St Boniface RC Church, members of all the churches will silently process through the town, carrying a huge cross, stopping at each church for a hymn and prayer. The walk finishes at CCC at the top of town followed by traditional refreshments.

Good Friday at St Swithun's at 2pm - A contemplative service remembering Jesus' last hours.

Easter Sunday - Beacon Church, New Buildings at 6.45am - Dawn Easter service with a fire to light the Easter candle and communion. Followed by Mike's bacon butties for breakfast.

Easter Sunday Communion at St Swithun's at 9.30am - A joyful celebration of Jesus' Resurrection.

(Remember the clocks go forward on Saturday 30th)

Sunday 7th April at St Swithun's at 9.30am - Communion, when Laura will join us as the preacher.

Sunday 7th April at St Swithun's at 3.30pm - Church Lite - a more informal way of doing church.

Should you want different styles or times of services, the full rota for the Crediton Hub is always pinned up in the church porch or can be found at the end of the monthly digital Hub Post.
