





## Crediton Parish Church – Friday 31 May and Saturday 1 June from 10am to 5pm and Sunday 2 June from 11am to 5pm

The Church of the Holy Cross in the heart of Crediton is one of the town's treasures. Do come along to this exhibition, highlighted with flowers, to celebrate and show off the many interesting features and artefacts in this historic church. Visit and see its fine architecture and learn its history through its stained glass, woodcarvings, sculpture and colourful vestments, its treasured 17th Century church silver and long music tradition. Take the challenge to find our Green Man! Over the centuries and up to the present day, the people who use this building are also treasures as is the peaceful churchyard now being recreated into a green community space. Make a fascinating visit to this Grade 1 listed building, one of the 350 major parish churches in England and featured in Simon Jenkins' book of One Thousand Best Churches. Enjoy a cream tea in the nearby Boniface Centre Café where light refreshments of coffee/tea/sandwiches/ cakes/cream teas will be served from 10am to 4pm on 31 May and 1 June and from 2pm to 4pm on 2 June.



#### **CREDITON ARTS CENTRE SUMMER SHOW**

Crediton Arts Centre, East Street, Crediton - Saturday 25 May to Saturday 1 June from 10am to 4pm and Sunday 2 June from 10am to 2pm.

Just over the road from Crediton Parish Church, you will find Crediton Arts Centre where for the first time, this summer show is another opportunity to see the work of local artists as part of the Arts Centre's ongoing programme through a variety of events, such as Town Trails and exhibitions at the Boniface Centre and the White Room. The Main Studio will be transformed into an exhibition space with artwork by 13 artists on show, covering a range of two and three-dimensional media, with an opportunity to buy original artwork as well as prints and cards. In Studio Two, the work of students who attend a variety of professionally led Arts Centre classes will be displayed. **Free entry.** 



**GROW COURSES** offer introductory learning opportunities for a wide range of roles over Zoom.

Primarily for lay people, these courses can be accessed by anyone and may be used as part of their discernment process or as learning for a current or future role.

This project aims to help our church members to grow in prayer, make new disciples and serve the people of Devon with joy through practical and specific learning.

Courses are certificated and can be undertaken without prior learning. Some participants join before or after undertaking Foundations in Christian Ministry, but these courses stand alone. Public recognition of this learning is really valuable, so we'd encourage all churches to acknowledge those who complete Grow courses. These courses can also be arranged as in-person training, if we have enough people to run a course in the Deanery.

Current courses include Digital Ministry, Prayer, Sharing our Faith, Children, Youth & Schools, Leading from the Front, Carbon Literacy, Creation Care, Pastoral Care, Social Action, Administration, Preaching, Small Group Leadership and more. These are always being added to and suggestions of new subjects are welcome.
