--- And finally ---

In a crazy world, one way of encouraging ourselves in God is to look back and see how God was there for previous saints in their world of injustice and pain. One such was George Muller who lived in Bristol about 120 years ago. He cared for 10,024 orphans and started 117 schools which educated 120,000 children with a Christian education. He never fund-raised or sent out begging letters, he prayed and trusted God to provide the money he needed - and God did to the tune of £90 million (in today's money.) He was accused of 'raising the poor above their natural state'. He said this about prayer:-

Pray as you can, not as you can't. ... The greater the difficulty to be overcome, the more will it be seen to the glory of God how much can be done by prayer and faith. Faith does not operate in the realm of the possible. There is no glory for God in that which is possible. Faith begins where man's power ends.'

(P.S. Talk to Elaine sometime, one of her great aunts was a little girl rescued by George Muller.)
