--- And Finally ---

Last Sunday Jeremy shared the results of a YouGov. survey. It had asked the same questions about people's beliefs, habits and church attendance in 2018 as in 2024 across a range of ages and demographics.

We are so used to being told the Christian church is in decline that the 2018 results were not a surprise. But in 2024 (and post pandemic) there was a marked growth in church attendance amongst almost all age groups and particularly among the young. For instance, the number of 16-24 year olds who attended church jumped from 4% to 16%. More men than women now go to church. Churches in particular that are 'outward facing', get involved with and support the local community are seeing greatest growth.

So what should our response to this 'Quiet Revival' be? Well of course we should be thankful - and pray for more. We should be prepared and make the most of every opportunity that we get, individually and as a church. The same church that doom-mongers suggest is only a generation away from extinction, can, by the power of God, be only a spark away from revival!
