--- And Finally ---

It's easy to pray for peace in our world, resolution of conflict, sharing of resources, a voice for the voiceless - but what might that actually look like? How would it start?

The Sandford Storytellers were in school on Monday presenting the story of Noah (so appropriate when the next day the school was closed because of floods!) and had a rare chance to watch an example.

A pupil had noted that sometimes children felt left out at playtime and went to talk to the head about an idea to improve the situation. Mrs Fee listened and suggested she design a poster with her idea and then share it with all the children at an assembly. So the pupil explained her idea of a Friendship Bench where you could sit if you were feeling alone and someone would come and chat with you or invite you to join their game. The rest of the school listened and added comments and decided to fundraise for the bench. Fundraising ideas included sponsored acts of kindness, making and selling friendship bracelets, a cake stall etc.

I mulled over that little scene the rest of the day because it had all the ingredients that world leaders would do well to copy. Listening, sharing, caring, empowering, including others, creatively meeting a need. What wonderful life lessons the children are learning at Sandford School!
